

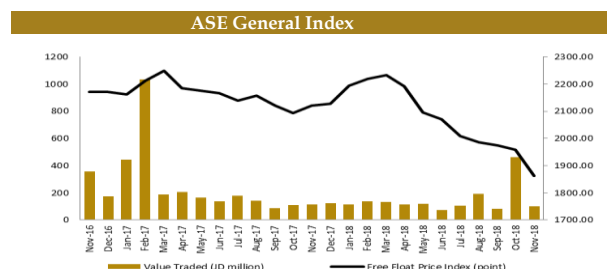

News and Updates

- The total amount of transactions processed through [Madfooatcom's eFAWATEERcom](#) grew by 96% during the first eleven months of 2018 to amount to JD 5,631 million, compared to JD 2,875.4 million recorded during the same period of 2017. *Central Bank of Jordan*
- Real estate trading in Jordan decreased by 14% during the first eleven months of 2018 to amount to JD 4,815 million, compared to JD 5,629 million recorded in the same period of 2017. *Department of Land and Survey*
- The number of sold apartments during the first eleven months of 2018 dropped to 31.1 thousand apartments, compared to 34.2 thousand apartments sold during the same period of 2017. *Department of Land and Survey*

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
