STOCK MARKET ACTIVITY FOR OCTOBER 2016

On the last trading session of October 2016 the General Index reached 66,50 points, representing a relative increase of 0,51% from the previous month. The value of shares traded exhibited a decrease of 21,65% compared to the previous month.

It is worth mentioning however, that the highest level that the General Index reached for the month was 66,95 points. The other Market Indices reached the following levels: Main Market reached 44,37, Alternative Market 772,87, Investment Companies 804,98 points.

On a sectoral level, the Hotels Index reached 553,77 points. The FTSE/CySE20 reached 38,59 points and finally the FTSE Med reached 4.492,43 points.

The market capitalisation of shares (shares) reached € 2,36 billion. According to this month's results, the Main Market accounted for 35,04% of the total market capitalisation, the Alternative Market 18,31%, the Surveillance Market 0,62% and the Bond Market 46,03%. Moreover, the total market capitalisation including the Bond Market reached € 4,37 billion compared to €4,65 billion the previous month, registering a decrease of 5,99%.

The total value of transactions during the month in review reached €4,07 million, with an average of € 0,20 million per trading session. The Financials sector contributed 78,77% to the total value traded which was the highest among all other sectors. Investors primarily focused their interest on the shares of "Bank of Cyprus Public Company Ltd" and also on shares of "Logicom Public Ltd" with 72,26% and 4,99% of the total value respectively.



Listing of Government Titles

13 weeks Treasury bills. On 6th October 2016, the Cyprus Stock Exchange announced that it has accepted the listing on the CSE of 100.000 13-Week Treasury Bills, 10th Issue, Series 2016 (7/10/2016 – 9/1/2017) of a nominal value of €1000 each, of a total value of €100.000.000, which have resulted from an auction carried out on 4 October 2016. Their date of issue was on 7th October 2016. The code of the above titles to be listed on the Bonds Market is ΓΔ13K16/ TB13J16. The Bills did not bear an interest rate. Their trading started on Friday, 7 October 2016.



Continuation of Suspension of Trading of Titles

Louis Plc. On 10th October 2016, further to its previous announcement of 9 August 2016, the Cyprus Stock Exchange announced the continuation of the suspension of trading of the titles of Louis Plc for an additional period of two (2) months, i.e. until 12 December 2016, due to the non-submission of the Yearly Financial Report for the year ended 31/12/2015 and the Quarterly Financial Report for the period ended 31/3/2016. The decision was taken pursuant to Article 185 of the Securities and Cyprus Stock Exchange Law and on the basis of the relevant Policy Decision of the Stock Exchange Council (Circular No. 3-2015, dated 13/7/2015 "CSE Policy regarding the suspension and delisting of securities on the CSE Markets").

In addition, it is noted that the said company has not submitted its Half-Yearly Financial Report for the period ended 30/6/2016.

It is further noted that if, within the above period of two months, the reasons for the suspension of trading of the titles of the above company cease to exist, the said suspension will be lifted.

Non Submission and Publication of the Half-Yearly Financial Report for the period ended 30 June 2016

On 10th October 2016, following the expiry of the period for the submission and publication (end of September 2016) of the Half-Yearly Financial Report of the companies listed on the CSE for the period ended 30 June 2016 as provided for in Article 142 of the Securities and Cyprus Stock Exchange Law, pursuant to paragraph 2.2.3(a) of Regulatory Administrative Act 379/2014 (as amended) and by application of its Policy Decision with Circular No. 03/2015, dated 13/07/2015, the Cyprus Stock Exchange announced that the below companies of the Regulated Market have failed to submit their half-yearly results:

It is noted that for the companies with an asterisk (*), the CSE Council has requested the approval of the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission for a possible delisting of their titles from the Cyprus Stock Exchange.

In addition, the titles of SEA STAR CAPITAL PLC will continue to be traded on the Surveillance Market due to the non submission and publication of its Half-Yearly Financial Report for the period ended 30/6/2016.

Delisting of Government Titles

Suspension of Trading and Delisting of Government Titles

13-week Treasury Bills. On 26th October 2016, the Cyprus Stock Exchange announced the suspension of trading of the 13-week Treasury Bills 8th Issue Series 2016 (5/8/2016 -4/11/2016), with code ΓΔ13Θ16 / TB13H16, from 1 November 2016 until 3 November 2016 (inclusive), i.e. until the clearing of all transactions in view of the delisting of the titles. The above Treasury Bills will be delisted on 4 November 2016.

Suspension of Trading of Titles

L.P. Transbeton Public Ltd. On 31st October 2016, the Cyprus Stock Exchange announced the end of the suspension of trading of the titles of L.P. Transbeton Public Ltd, as the total period for the suspension of trading granted by the Securities and Exchange Commission by virtue of the powers vested in it by Article 127(2) of the Investment Services and Activities and Regulated Markets Laws of 2007 to 2016 has elapsed. It is reminded that the Council of the Stock Exchange has already decided to delist the company's titles from the CSE and the Securities and Exchange Commission is expected to approve the decision.









Economic Group weighting of Market Capitalisation (shares-month end)



History

The Cyprus Stock Exchange started operations as a legal entity on March 29 1996, based on the Laws and Regulations concerning the Cyprus Stock Exchange, which were enacted by the House of Representatives, Parliament of the Republic of Cyprus in 1993 and 1995 respectively.

The Cyprus Stock Exchange is an organized securities market through which transactions on listed securities take place, such as government bonds, warrants, stocks or any other securities that are listed on the stock exchange.

The main participants in the market are the Members of the stock exchange (stock brokerage companies), custodians, issuers, as well as investors. The CSE is managed by its Board, which is appointed by the government of the Republic of Cyprus.
