
A total turnover of 2.265 billion shares worth N20.990 billion in 23,722 deals were traded this week by investors on the floor of the Exchange, in contrast to a total of 1.675 billion shares valued at N25.425 billion that exchanged hands last week in 23,650 deals.

The Financial Services industry (measured by volume) led the activity chart with 1.884 billion shares valued at N14.933 billion traded in 13,602 deals; thus contributing 83.15% and 71.14% to the total equity turnover volume and value respectively. The Consumer Goods Industry followed with 116.400 million shares worth N2.817 billion in 3,474 deals. The third place was Conglomerates Industry, with a turnover of 107.803 million shares worth N231.323 million in 897 deals.

Trading in the top three equities namely Jaiz Bank Plc, United Bank for Africa Plc and Zenith Bank Plc (measured by volume) accounted for 894.000 million shares worth N7.077 billion in 4,045 deals, contributing 39.47% and 33.72% to the total equity turnover volume and value respectively.



Notification of Lifting of Suspension Placed on Trading in the Shares of Niger Insurance Plc

We refer to our Market Bulletin dated 1 September 2020 with Reference Number: NSE/RD/LRD/MB43/20/09/01, wherein we notified Dealing Members of the suspension of six (6) listed companies for non-compliance with Rule 3.1, Rules for Filing of Accounts and Treatment of Default Filing, Rulebook of The Exchange (Issuers' Rules) ("Default Filing Rules"), which provides that; "If an Issuer fails to file the relevant accounts by the expiration of the Cure Period, The Exchange will:

- a. Send to the Issuer a "Second Filing Deficiency Notification" within two (2) business days after the end of the Cure Period;
- b. Suspend trading in the Issuer's securities; and
- c. Notify the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and the Market within twenty- four (24) hours of the suspension."

Niger Insurance Plc, one (1) of the six (6) listed companies that were suspended on 1 September 2020, has now filed its outstanding financial statements with The Exchange.

In view of the Company's submission of its outstanding financial statements, and pursuant to Rule 3.3, of the Default Filing Rules, which states that; "The suspension of trading in the issuer's securities shall be lifted upon submission of the relevant accounts provided The Exchange is satisfied that the accounts comply with all applicable rules of The Exchange. The Exchange shall thereafter also announce through the medium by which the public and the SEC was initially notified of the suspension, that the suspension has been lifted", Dealing Members are hereby notified that the suspension placed on trading on the shares of Niger Insurance Plc was lifted today, Thursday, 10 December 2020.

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
