



STOCK MARKET REPORT FOR DECEMBER 16TH, 2016

It was a four-day trading week as the Federal Government of Nigeria declared Monday 12th of December, 2016 as Public Holiday in commemoration of the Eid-el-Maulud Celebration.

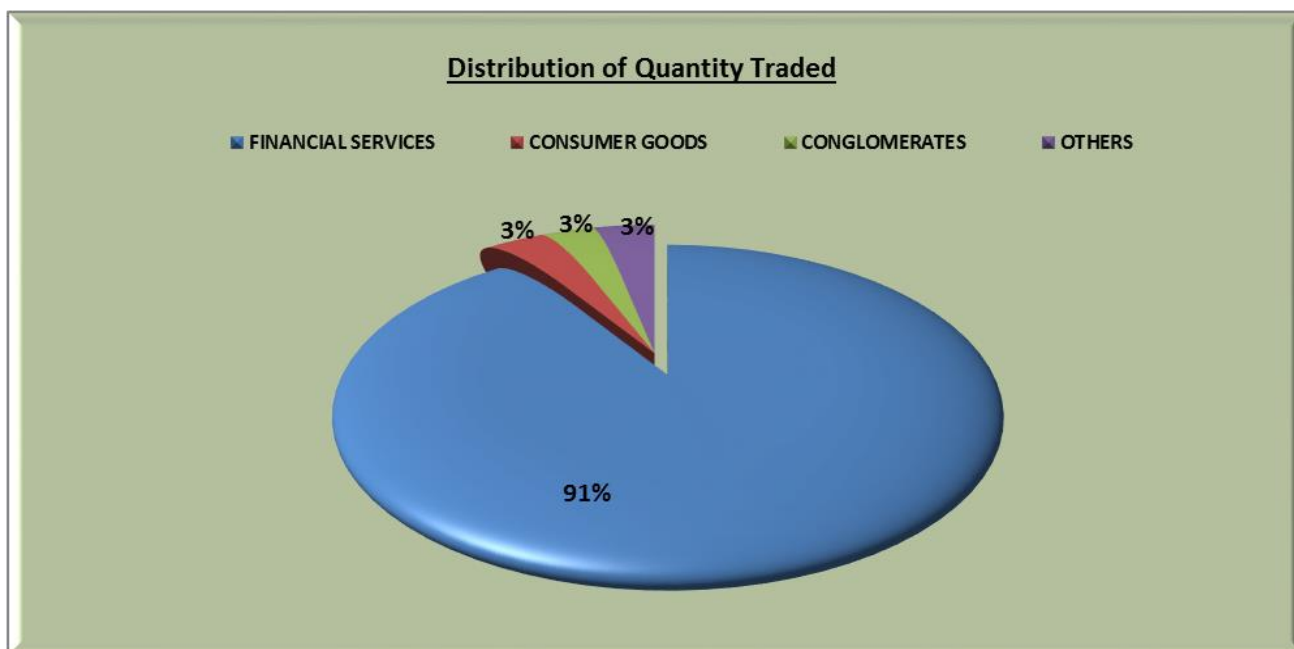
Meanwhile, a turnover of 1.656 billion shares worth N12.580 billion in 12,860 deals were traded this week by investors on the floor of the Exchange in contrast to a total of 894.759 million shares valued at N10.629 billion that exchanged hands last week in 13,418 deals.

The Financial Services Industry (measured by volume) led the activity chart with 1.504 billion shares valued at N6.183 billion traded in 7,311 deals; thus contributing 90.82% and 49.15% to the total equity turnover volume and value respectively. The Consumer Goods Industry followed with 51.395 million shares worth N4.753 billion in 2,027 deals. The third place was occupied by the Conglomerates Industry with a turnover of 46.282 million shares worth N52.408 million in 553 deals.

Trading in the Top Three Equities namely – Union Bank NigeriaPlc, United Bank For Africa Plc and FCMB Group Plc (measured by volume) accounted for 865.701 million shares worth N3.370 billion in 999 deals, contributing 52.26% and 26.79% to the total equity turnover volume and value respectively.

INDEX MOVEMENT

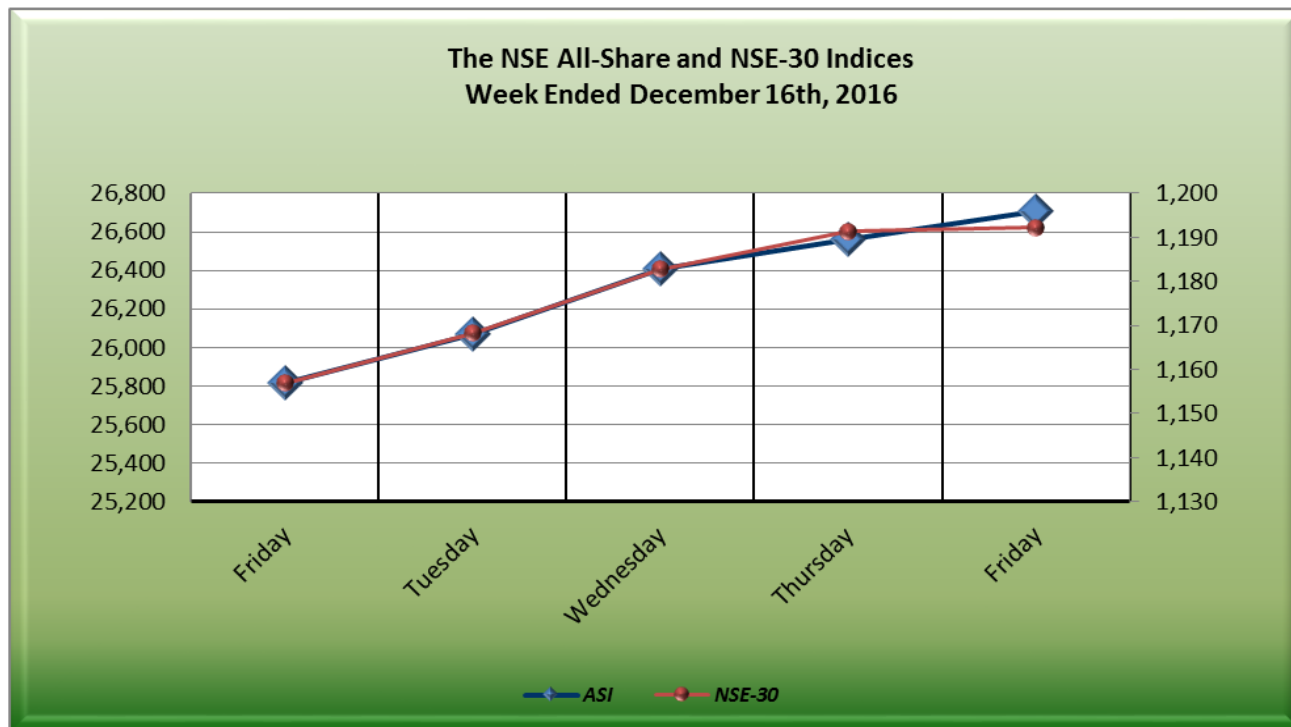
The NSE All-Share Index and Market Capitalization appreciated by 3.44% to close the week at 26,707.10 and N9.189 trillion respectively.
