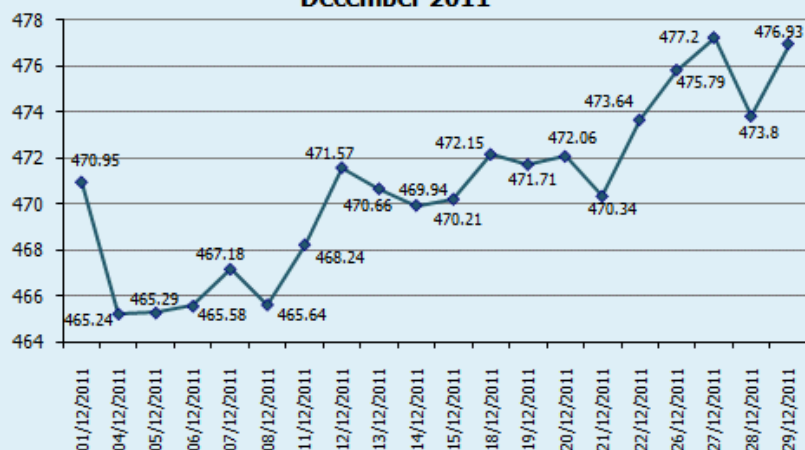


Al-Quds Index

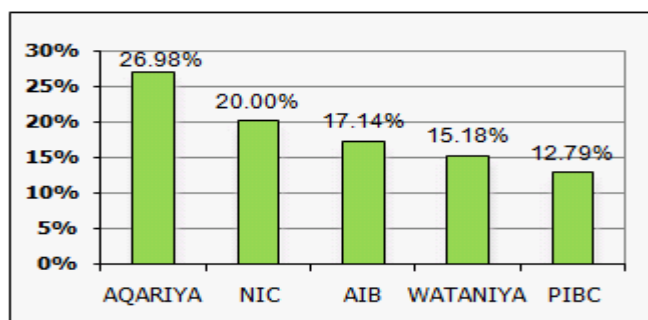
Daily closing of AL- Quds index during December 2011



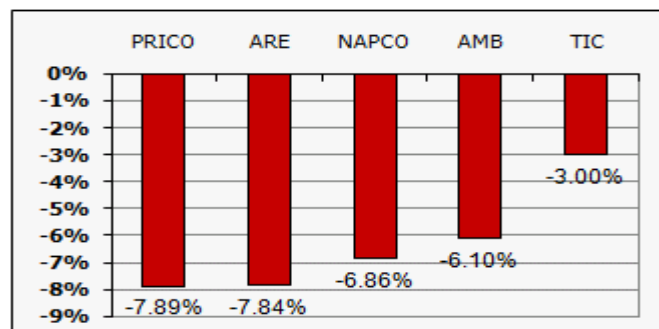

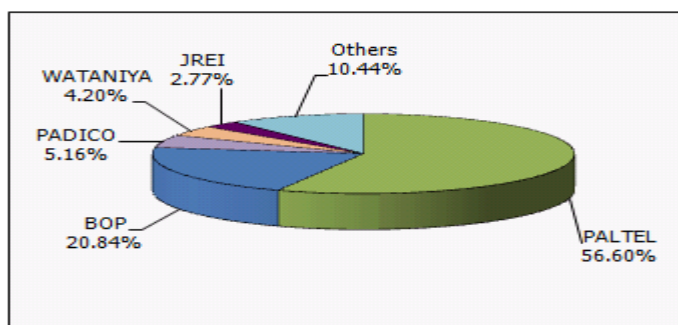

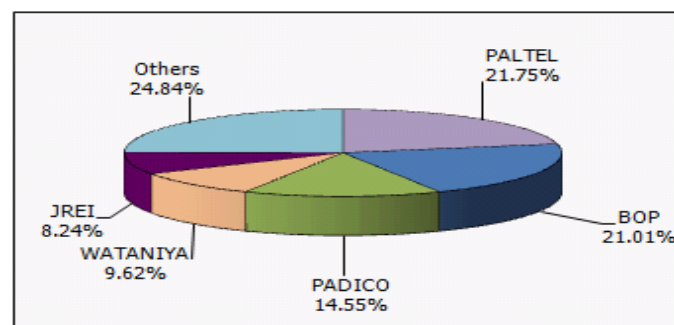
